* Symptoms

- Fever (100.4°F or above)
- Cough
- Shortness of Breath
- Chest Pain
- Tiredness, Confusion
- Bluish lips or face
- Runny nose
- Sore throat
- Lost sense of smell or taste
- Diarrhea

** Close Contact

What is considered Close Contact:

- Household member.
- Intimate partner.
- Individual providing care in a household without using recommended infection control precautions.
- Individual who was directly coughed on.
- Individual who spent 15 minutes or more within 6 feet or less of the positive individual that did not wear a facemask to block respiratory secretions from contaminating others and the environment.

*** CDC Precautions

- Employers should measure the employee's temperature and assess symptoms before the individual enters the facility every day.
- Employee should self-monitor under the supervision of their employer's occupational health program.
- The employee should wear a face mask or employer approved cloth face covering at all times while in the workplace.
